



Notes on the Application for 2021/2022 Secondary One Discretionary Places (S1DP)

- Starting from 4 January 2021, application forms for 2021/2022 Secondary One Discretionary Places can be collected at the main entrance of the school or be downloaded from the school website (www.ktklgss.edu.hk).
- Submission period: From 4 January 2021 to 18 January 2021 (Late applications will not be accepted.)
Submission time: Monday to Friday: from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Saturday: from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon
- The completed application form must be submitted **by hand** to the general office **during office hours**. When submitting the application form, please bring the original copy of the H.K.I.D. Card of the applicant for verification. The application form should be submitted together with the following documents:
 - Completed Application Form for S1DP issued by our school
 - Completed Application Form for S1DP issued by the Education Bureau
 - Photocopies of the applicant's school reports for Primary 5 and Primary 6Remarks:
 - * According to the EDB, there is no need to provide any letters of recommendation.
 - * Please **DO NOT** send by email or by fax.

- The admission criteria and weightings are as follows:

Admission Criteria	Weightings (%)
Academic performance	30%
Conduct	20%
Interview performance	30%
Extra-curricular activities involvement	10%
Others:	10%
a. Son/ Brother of a former student	
b. Awards	
Total	100%

- All applicants will be invited to attend an interview on **30 January 2021 (Saturday)**. The time of the interview will be given upon submitting the application form.
- Parents of all successful applicants will be notified by letter and phone on 31 March 2021.
- The admission result will be announced on 6 July 2021 concurrently with the release of the Central Allocation results.
- When seeking further information, parents must provide us with the reference number shown on the application form and the first four digits of the applicant's ID number for protecting the applicant's privacy.

Remarks :

- Each student may apply to **NOT MORE THAN TWO** participating secondary schools listed in the Handbook for Application for Secondary 1 Discretionary Places, otherwise his chance of acquiring a DP will be forfeited.
- All personal data is used confidentially. It is only used for processing the admission of 2020/2021 S1 Discretionary Places.
- If face-to face teaching is forbidden by EDB on the Interview Day (30 January 2021), the interview will be cancelled accordingly. The admission criteria and weightings will be amended as follows: Marks for interview performance will be cancelled. The total marks will be 70 instead of 100.
- There will be 40 Secondary One Discretionary Places in the academic year 2021-2022.
